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Good news! Washington State Rep. Michelle Caldier, working directly with GHP FISH volunteers, has come up with a \$150,000 matching state grant for our building project. It has passed the House and now awaits approval by the Senate. Of course we will need to raise another \$150,000 in order to take full advantage of the grant, but I am confident that we can do that. This is not the first time Michelle has assisted us. She is a long-time supporter of GHP FISH.

This is just one of the many great things that happened in the past few months. Thanks to our more than 200 volunteers and to our generous community, we provided assistance to more of our neighbors than ever. Last fiscal year, 4,226 families received enough food to provide at least 207,942 meals. Our local stores remain vital partners in making this possible. Additionally, generous financial support from local community members allowed us to purchase over \$89,000 in perishables and hygiene items. On the downside, in the last few months we have seen a growing number of people needing help, also the number of elderly needing assistance continues to increase.

A team of expert volunteers is currently working to determine the feasibility of building on the Hunt Street property that we received from Pierce Transit through the city. A number of permitting issues must be dealt with prior to moving ahead. The geography of the land and the fact that we are dealing with two parcels rather than one is complicating the situation. Hopefully, we will be able to resolve the problems in the near future.
